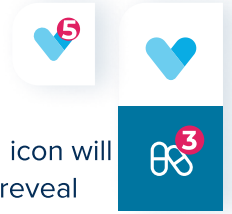




Vim Rx Assist - Technical Walkthrough

Get Started



When Vim has medication recommendations, the Vim icon will light up and when clicked, reveal the Rx Assist application icon.

Recommendation Types

There are (6) possible recommendations that can appear between two different categories:

Changing Medications: Start, Discontinue, or Switch medications

Start new medication: **Albuterol** ⓘ

Discontinue: **Spriva respimat** ⓘ

Switch medication: **Spriva Respimat** ⓘ

Alternative Breztri

Cost impact ⓘ **\$516** ↓

Pharmacist notes
Patient on Spiriva/Incruse; can reduce patient medication burden and costs by switching to Breztri.

Each recommendation card will show pharmacist approved information, such as:

Included information

Suggested Adjustment

Alternative medication name, new dosage, new admin route.

Cost Impact

Where applicable and cost data is available. Note: this is in reference to the impact to the *total cost of care*.

Pharmacist notes

Additional context, suggestions, and other relevant information directly from the pharmacist in relation to the recommendation.

Changing Patient Regimen: Schedule, Dosage, or Administration Route.

Change schedule: **Metformin 500mg** ⓘ

Change dosage: **Metformin 500mg** ⓘ

Suggested new dosage
Metformin 1000mg

Change administration route: **Testosterone Gel** ⓘ

Suggested new administration route
Testosterone Injection

Review Recommendation

Accept Dismiss

Each recommendation will show an Accept & Dismiss button. This allows users to provide feedback to the insurer on validity of the recommendations. If dismissed, the user will be asked for additional information:
