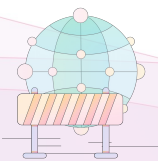

Providers are empowered and experience less burden and friction created by inbound chart requests as Vim automatically powers the extraction through an in-EHR connection.

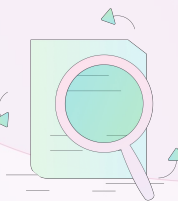
Vim Data Exchange:



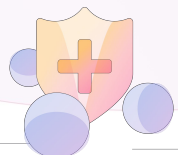
